Specific focus for Falconer – school building and equipment.	Reviewed photos taken by young people and considered what was good and difficult about areas. Particular points of note for the young people were: 1. Not a large enough ICT suite and not enough computers for the five children in the ICT suite 2. Broken doors 3. The trampoline is a good new thing but the bounce is not good enough to get the feedback needed for sensory breaks 4. The new way into the school is causing some discussion so there is a trial period for one week 5. Want a bigger forest school and to develop it further using the fruits etc 6. Need benches outside to sit on 7.
